

Campendo

General Camp Rules:

CAMPERS are not allowed to bring CELL PHONES.

All phones that are brought will be promptly confiscated.

All medication must be turned-over to the Camp Nurse at check-in.

The Camp Nurse is responsible for administering *all* medication.

(This includes vitamins)

Dress modestly.

Shorts worn at camp must be fingertip length when your hands are straight at your sides. Girls must wear a one-piece bathing suit, or wear a dark t-shirt over their bathing suit.

If you are not sure if it's ok to wear, don't bring it.

No food or drink permitted on the bus *(water is allowed)*.

DON'T BRING ANY FOOD TO CAMP

Be honest.

Stay away from *all* animals.

Speak kindly to one another.

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen (Ephesians 4:29).

DO NOT bring any money to camp.

(everyone at camp has an account at the Snack Shack)

No fighting.

Hitting, kicking, biting, or any other physical assault is never acceptable behavior, and is cause for IMMEDIATE dismissal from camp.

Wear a *clean* change of clothes to chapel.

No stealing.

No one may use something that belongs to someone else without the permission of the owner.

Place all *found* items in the “**Lost & Found**” area.

No vandalism.

Campers are not allowed to deface anything at camp.

This includes writing, drawing, carving, or painting, unless authorized as an activity, during chapel, or group time.

Don't litter.

Snack shack will close down if litter becomes excessive.

Buddy System

Campers are to be with their buddy at all times.

Campers will be paired with their buddy during the first cabin session.

*When a camper is found without their buddy,
both will temporarily lose privileges.*

Campers are not allowed to switch buddies without going to their cabin leader first. All buddies involved in the switch, including old and new buddies must be present and agree to the switch.

Water Safety

Swim only in designated areas.

Practice safe habits in and around water.

Campers must pass a swim test in order to swim without a life vest.

A life vest must be worn when boating.

Disputes

Issues between campers and staff will be settled promptly with and by the Camp Directors or the Camp Pastor.

Amendments

The Camp Directors and the Camp Pastor reserve the right to create new rules as needed.

Camptendo

Cabin Rules:

During Silent Hours, campers must remain on their bunk.

Cabins are to function as a team.

No food allowed in the cabins or in the gym (chapel).

(unless planned by staff for a camp activity)

DON'T BRING ANY FOOD TO CAMP

Dining Hall Rules:

Absolutely no food fights.

ONLY Special Forces serve meals.

(Special Forces = High School Leaders)

Campers are expected to sit with their cabins
at their assigned tables during meals.

Mind your manners and keep your table *clean*.

Restroom and Shower Rules:

All campers are *encouraged* to shower daily.

(private showers will be provided at camp)

All campers are required to use
designated restrooms for their *intended* purposes.
Relieving one's self in the lake or woods is **not permitted**.

Change your clothes *daily*.
